On behalf of NWBS we are pleased to announce registration procedures for the Huib Petersen workshops to be held at the Maplewood Rock & Gem Club on November 4, 5, and 6, 2016. Please read through the registration steps carefully.

Registration requires two steps: (1) email me at vp@nwbeadsociety.org to let me know you would like to be entered into the log of class participants and (2) mail a completed registration form and payment, along with a 2016 NWBS membership application and 2016 dues, if applicable.

IF YOU ARE NOT A CURRENT MEMBER – If you are not a NWBS member and/or you haven't paid your 2016 dues, you **MUST** send a membership application/renewal form and 2016 dues of \$30 in **with your registration**. If you don't do so, we will not be able to include you in the class log until you complete membership registration. You can find both the renewal application and new member application here:

If you think you'll be interested in a kit, please indicate "Yes" on the registration form; you will have an opportunity to withdraw your kit selection once we have received the pricing information.

spring fling bracelets



I love spring time. In the city where I used to live all the parks would fill with these flowers in the spring time.

These four spring and summer bracelets, wearable each separate or combined as a corsage, are stitched in peyote stitch combined with herringbone stitch. The bracelets have a memory wire frame which keeps them nicely wrapped around the wrist.

The class focusses on the diagonal peyote stitch and its variations.

Level intermediate to advanced.

For the Iris

15 grams blue

5 grams yellow

2 grams beige

12 grams each light and medium green

For the Daffodil

12 grams yellow

5 grams orange

2 grams beige

12 grams each light and medium green

For the Tulip

12 grams opaque red

3 grams matte red

3 grams matte black

3 grams yellow

12 grams each light and medium green

For the Marguerite (Daisy)

3 grams yellow

12 grams white

12 grams each light and medium green

*** FOR EACH FLOWER**

2 6mm beads

Bracelet memory wire

Hypo cement (watchmakers glue)

Needles and thread

bike chain bracelet



This bracelet is stitched in Cubic and Prism Right Angle Weave, two different links are connected with a post that slides through the circular spaces in the links. The Design reminds me of an ordinary bicycle chain and makes a wonderful accessory.

During class we will practice hands on the many possibilities of combining these two stitches.

Experience with cubic right angle weave is recommended for this class.
