

Judy Walker Workshops Registration Instructions

On behalf of NWBS we are pleased to announce registration procedures for the Judy Walker workshops to be held at the Maplewood Rock and Gem Club on October 13, 14, and 15, 2017.

Registration requires two steps: (1) email me at nita_cherry@hotmail.com to let me know you would like to be entered into the class log and (2) mail a completed registration form and payment, along with a 2017 NWBS membership application and 2017 dues, if applicable. If you do not email me and only mail in your class registration, and the class is full by the time we receive your registration, you will be contacted and asked if you'd like to be put on a waitlist. If you email me, you will be immediately confirmed in the class log, as long as you mail your registration within a few days.

Workshops

Friday

Friday's workshop is Star Sphere. Please see a picture and details in the attached page. Since supplies are so simple, there will be no kits.

Judy will provide a FREE copy of her book The Beaded Sphere to everyone who takes a workshop. The book is full of dimensional bead projects and after taking the Star Sphere workshop you should be able to easily follow all of the projects in the book.

Saturday and Sunday

Saturday will be Beginning Loom with Judy's Paper Clip Loom. This is a specially designed loom that eliminates weaving in of warp threads. In Saturday's class you can make one of the four patterns pictured (see attached), or bring your own basic, square or rectangular pattern. Since supplies are so simple, there will be no kits. You can bring your own Delicas/Aikos, favorite thread, and you will need special bead loom needles like these

Sunday will be Advanced Loom with Judy's Loom. Please see the attached page for a description of the techniques we will learn in this class.

****You can bring your own loom if you like! Judy will show you how to warp your loom and weave in the threads.**

Judy will have her looms for sale in class. The prices are \$75 for a small loom and \$90 for a medium loom. The small loom (as it comes) will make a 5 inch wide by 8 inch long project. The medium loom will make a 10 inch wide by 14 inch long project. You can lengthen the project for either loom up to SIX FEET! long by buying additional rods, readily available at any hardware store.

IF YOU ARE NOT A CURRENT MEMBER – If you are not a NWBS member and/or you haven't paid your 2017 dues, you **MUST** send a membership application/renewal form and 2017 dues of \$30 in **with your registration**. If you don't do so, we will not be able to include you in the class log until you complete membership registration. Star Sphere

Class Requirements

This astonishing hollow beaded sphere is entirely self supporting. The mesmerizing geometry is not difficult, but is absorbing and challenging. It is helpful, but not required, that students have some peyote skills, especially in odd count flat peyote and the “funny turn”. The sphere won’t be finished during class, but you will learn all the techniques you need to finish on your own.




Materials needed:

- 20 grams of background color beads - in the picture, those would be the purple beads
 - 10 grams of star color beads - in the picture, those would be the gold beads
- Suggestions:* Use two colors with a strong contrast - opaque colors are best. Transparent colors do not work as well. AIKO cylinder beads are highly recommended but Delicas will be fine.
- Basic beading supplies such as needles (size 10 recommended), scissors, beading surface, mat or tray, supplemental lighting if desired
 - Nymo B or D thread or your favorite beading thread such as KO or One-G. Please note that Fireline, Power Pro or other similar threads are not the best choice for this project

Advanced Paper Clip Looming Techniques

Class Requirements

This class assumes that students already know the fundamentals of bead loom weaving, and how to use the Paper Clip Loom. Students are welcome to bring their own loom (please have them check with me beforehand to make sure it will be adequate for the class project).

- Paper Clip Bead Loom with paper clips. Small loom is \$75, medium loom is \$90. The class project will fit on the small loom (shown).
- Blue painter's masking tape (also called low-tack or easy release) - I will bring some for all students.
- Ruler or measuring tape - I will have some to lend.
- Smoke Fireline 4# or 6#, or similar material. Dark color is best.
- Basic beading supplies such as needles, scissors, beading surface, mat or tray, supplemental lighting if desired.
- Needed to finish the necklace, but not needed during class: two decorative buttons, about ½ inch in diameter.
- The following beads are needed for this project. A kit containing these beads will be available for \$30.

Gold - DB-31 - 7g

Green - DB-046 - 3.5g

Aqua - DB-1208 - 6g

BlueGreen - DB-608 - 3.5g

Blue - DB-047 - 2.5g

DarkPurple - DB-609 - 2g

Purple - DB-610 - 1.5g

The following techniques will be discussed, although not all of these techniques are used in the class project:

Weaving using only some of the warp threads

Increasing on left or right edge

Decreasing on left or right edge

Increasing or decreasing by more than one bead at a time

Split loom techniques: starting a new thread, traveling, weaving downwards

Leaving open slots - pulling warp threads aside

Smooth side decreases

Supplemented warp technique - leaving a hole

Pulling warp threads to finish

Sewing in warp threads to finish

Square stitch additions at top and bottom

Square stitch bump outs at sides
